The PEEC Main Meeting convened at 6:30 pm in the Dona Ana Room of the Corbett Center at New Mexico State University in Las Cruces, NM at the 2007 North American Power Symposium.

Announcements: The following universities have new power engineering faculty hires for 2007-2008: University of Nevada-Reno, University of Missouri-Rolla, Colorado School of Mines, North Carolina State University, Arizona State University. Also UT-Arlington has a ECE department chair opening

Subcommittee Reports

Awards – Anil Pahwa reported that Joe Chow, et. al, RPI received the 2006 Prize Paper Award. The plaque was not presented at the GM07 because of a mix-up.

Life Long Learning – Sukumar Brahma reported that they have already unofficially rotated SC officers. The T&D and PSCE conferences were officially added to their responsibilities. Their website has been updated. The Expert Now modules will be facilitated by their SC. The modules will be offered as a tutorial first. There is now a surplus sharing agreement in place for authors of Tutorials. Further Tutorial presenters will keep their copyright so these materials will not be sold by IEEE.

Career Promotion – A workshop on Power Engineering Workforce is being organized by C.C. Liu and Wanda Reder in November in Arlington, VA. Also Alex Flueck is organizing a panel for GM08 on K-12 outreach.

Research – Tom Overbye announced that the new secretary will be Chika Nwanka with the SC rotates officers in January 2008. Further NAPS will be technically co-sponsored by IEEE PES. There will be four panels organized by this SC at GM08 in Pittsburgh: Gerry Heydt's panel on Sustainability; George Karady's panel on Power Laboratories at Universities outside U.S.; Felix Wu's panel on Power Research in China and East Asia; Dagmar Neibur's panel on NSF Career Awards and ONR YIPs.

Student Meetings – Joydeep Mitra reported that there will be student meetings associated with the following 2008 conferences, NAPS08, GM08, and T&D08.

Old Business

TCPC PEEC – Mariesa Crow reported that only a few papers were submitted to T&D for PEEC. They are currently under review. November 30, 2007 is the deadline for papers and panel

summaries for GM08. GM09 in Calgary will be held at a smaller venue than other recent GM. Therefore, there will be a push to limit paper sessions and committee meetings.

New Business

There was discussion on the earliness of the GM paper/panel submission deadlines. Also issues about plagiarism and increasing paper quality were discussed.

Gerry Heydt gave an update on the PEEC secretary election. The nominating subcommittee included Gerry, Bernie Lesieutre, and Bill Rosehart. The candidates are Tom Overbye, Joydeep Mitra, and Anil Pahwa. The election will conclude at noon on Monday, October 1st. The winner will be announced on Tuesday at the NAPS luncheon.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:15 pm.
