

## Computer Science Introductory Course Placement (Applies to most ECE Freshmen)

Most freshmen will register for **CS1121 in either Fall or Spring**. If you have had programming experience you can take the CS placement test and may be able to advance to **CS1131**. Students can sign up for CS1121 during the Registration period and then take the test online or at Orientation. Your schedule can be changed later if you are able to take CS1131.

**You can take the [CS Placement Test online](#)**. By placing into CS 1131 instead of CS 1121, you will not have to take CS 1122 (CpE Majors). or contact the CS Department 906-487-2209.

If at the time you register there is not an open section of CS1121 that you can add to your schedule because of conflicts with your cohort schedule, you should see Tina Sarazin in Rm 112 Dillman to request a change to your cohort schedule.
